

Angioplasty

Angioplasty is an endovascular procedure to widen narrowed or obstructed arteries or veins, typically to treat coronary obstructions. A deflated balloon is passed over a wire into the narrowing and then inflated to a fixed size; then a stent is implanted if needed.

CCSVI

CCSVI, or Chronic Cerebro-Spinal Venous Insufficiency, is a condition in which the jugular and azygous veins, which drain blood from the brain and spinal cord to the rest of the body, are narrowed, malformed, missing or otherwise blocked.
